(3rd Kyu & above competitors are not required to arrive at the venue until 1:00pm)

Entry fees:

→ £15 for Individual Kata or Kumite or £25 to enter both categories

- → Email your club entry forms (competitor + referee/judge/timekeeper) to technical@jka-england.org by the end of Friday 15th October 2021
- → You will receive confirmation of receipt
- → An Invoice with full international payment details will be emailed upon receipt of your entry forms. Payment must be received by Monday 18 October 2021

Please note:

- → Each club/organisation should submit both a competitor registration form and a referee/judge/timekeeper form.
- → Club chief instructors (or club representative) should submit the entry forms. (No individual entries).
- → Competitors, Judges/Referees plus the Club's Chief Instructor must all hold a valid Membership Licence on the day of the Championships (which they may be asked to produce)
- → Each club is required to nominate an individual who, on the day of the Championships, will act as coach and be responsible for collecting the competitor entry numbers, labels and details.
- → Age and grade of a competitor is at the closing date for entries, Friday 15th October 2021, not the date of the championships. Please check these details before entering your students.
- → If there are not enough entries in a category, the competitors will be moved to the next appropriate category.
- → Late entries may not be randomised and could all be placed at the end of the category in one grouping.
- → Kata & kumite categories, rules and safety information please refer to the "JKAE Open Championships 2021 Categories and Rules of Entry" document.
- → Photographs and video footage will be taken throughout the event. These will be used for marketing and publicity in our publications, on our website and on social media or in any third-party publication. Kindly contact the event organiser if you have any concerns or if you wish to be exempted from this activity.



COVID-19: Stay safe and help prevent the spread

JKA England and K2 Crawley are keen to ensure that COVID-19 safety protocols are observed by all who attend the Open Championships. Please familiarise yourself and all participants/spectators with the below guidelines.

- → Please conduct a lateral flow test at home the day before the event and only attend if you have a negative result.
- → Please DO NOT attend if you have COVID-19 symptoms or have been asked to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace.
- → Please practice social distancing where possible and consider wearing a face covering when moving around the venue.
- → Brown and Black Belt competitors are not required to arrive at the venue until 1:00pm as 3rd Kyu & above events are scheduled for the afternoon. This will help reduce capacity and allow for more effective social distancing.
- → Please DO NOT congregate for longer than necessary
- → SPECTATORS should practice social distancing (where possible) in the seating provided and MUST NOT enter the competition area during the Championship.
- → COACHES should wear a face covering whilst on the competition area.
- → COMPETITORS should wear a face covering whilst on the competition area and remove it prior to competing.
- → COMPETITORS should not share mitts or other equipment.
- → OFFICIALS should wear a face covering whilst on the competition area.

We reserve the right to change the date or cancel the Open Championship in line with UK Government rules that could change at any time. JKA England is not responsible for any costs that individuals or teams may incur in planning to attend the event, including transportation or accommodation. JKA England will refund any competition entry fees should the event be cancelled, or the date changed (if the new date is not suitable for the registered team or individual).
